# **EPA Proposed Group Standards for Treated Seed**

The EPA received 22 submissions on the Proposed Group Standard for Treated Seed.

SGNZ provided an importer and seed treatment applicator submission on behalf of members.

Our position was supportive of the standard with further edits and clarifications. We considered further engagement was required. The EPA has 30 days to review submissions. Thanks to all those who provided input and feedback.

## **MPI Biosecurity Act Review of Submissions**

Key sections for SGNZ included development of import health standards, Section 24 independent review panels (MPI proposing to amend its review mechanism) and enabling third party verification at transitional facilities.

SGNZ will email out next steps when these are known.

# **EPA** 's Proposed chlorpyrifos ban

SGNZ attended the EPA's chlorpyrifos hearing on the 9<sup>th</sup> April.

The Committee's indicated they required further information on chlorpyrifos use in arable seed production and vegetable seed production with regards to grass-grub control.

SGNZ will be following up the Committee's requests shortly.
