6.3	Germination Standards	Germination results for a seed lot must meet the germination standard as detailed in the ISF 'Standards for the main vegetable species'. Seed lots for which the germination result does not meet the germination standard as detailed in the ISF 'Standards for the main vegetable species', must be sold with a waiver. Germination testing and results need to be obtained from legitimate seed testing laboratories accredited by IANZ or ISTA. Evidence of accreditation will be requested. In the absence of accreditation comparative testing by an accredited lab will need to be conducted.	All seed lines sold since the previous audit meet the germination standards as deemed by the ISF or has been sold with a waiver. Laboratories used for seed testing must have IANZ or ISTA accreditation, OR Comparative testing has been carried out by an IANZ or ISTA accredited lab and results within 5%.		
6.4	Germination Retest	Germination retesting of seed stock for sale must be carried out at minimum of annually for each seed lot. Germination testing and results need to be obtained from legitimate seed testing laboratories accredited by IANZ or ISTA. Evidence of accreditation will be requested. In the absence of accreditation comparative testing by an accredited lab will need to be conducted.	All seed held in stock since the previous audit has undergone annual germination retesting. Laboratories used for seed testing must have ILAC or ISTA accreditation, OR Comparative testing has been carried out by an ILAC or ISTA accredited lab and results within 5%.		

6.5	Foodborne Disease Testing	Seed that is sold for sprouting must be tested for presence of E.coli and Salmonella and must not be sold if levels exceed industry accepted thresholds. Testing of seed for foodborne pathogens needs to be carried out by laboratories that are part of ILAC.	All sprouting seed lines purchased since the previous audit have undergone testing and do not exceed: - Salmonella; - E. coli; 100cfu/g Laboratories used for seed testing must be accredited through ILAC.		
7.0	Product Identification and Traceability	 Each seed parcel has: a) The presence of, or the allocation of, a unique lot designation which are specific to seed supplier, species and seed variety. b) The ability to be traced from the original supplier through to its sale to the purchaser. Records for all lot designations will be maintained for a minimum of two years after last sale. 	All seed held in storage at the time of the audit verified to confirm allocation of a unique lot designation. All seed lines sold since the previous audit have traceability from the supplier to the customer. Records for seed lots sold over the past two years are available.		
8.0	Retention Samples	It is advisable that signatories hold retention samples of all lot designations for a period of two years after last sale.	This is a non-critical point however is good practice.

Traceable certification by a recognised organic certification body available for Organic seed.
